Paul Clifford, M.D., Musculoskeletal Section, Department of Radiology, University of Miami Miller School of Medicine

Investigated a hypothetical etiology for rotator cuff pathology—sleep position. Discovered an increased incidence of rotator cuff disease in two sleep positions, compared with a third, more protective position. Patients were asked questions regarding shoulder usage and sleep position and those responses were compared with the results of their recent shoulder MRI.
