My name is Brittney McDonald and I am a certified physician associate. I am sending my cover letter and attached CV in reference to your request for an expert witness.

I have been immersed in healthcare since I was 3 years old, when my father broke his back while working for the local 2168 union. Since then, I have gained expansive knowledge on worker's compensation and malpractice through both personal and professional experience. Because of my extensive personal history with workers compensation, I was promoted to site lead after 9 months of employment at OCPN, opening their newest office in East Bridgewater. There, I worked hand in hand with a spinal surgeon to document independent medical examinations, prepare deposition paperwork, and assisted in documentation for worker's compensation cases. I worked closely with the worker's compensation department and nurse case managers to assess, file correct paperwork, and determine length of disability.

My extensive work at OCPN with worker's compensation is what drove my desire to continue my education with a doctorate in health law. I loved being a part of both medicine and the legal aspects of cases. I enjoyed the documentation and review of independent medical examinations, determining the course of treatment followed by other providers, what the standard treatment guidelines are, and where deviations occurred, if any. Part of my job as lead medical assistant was to comb through IME documentation prior to the physician, and highlight areas of interest or deviation from standard of care. Because of this, I quickly learned the standard of care for the vast majority of injuries.

With the knowledge that I gained at OCPN in hand, I began my first physician associate job at AFC urgent care. In this position, we contracted with numerous companies and quickly became the central spot for employee health and workers compensation. On a given day, I would see 5-10 workers compensation related injuries as well as the same amount of patients for DOT and 7D physical examinations. I gained hands-on experience as a provider, documenting courses of injuries and standard of care, and ultimately sending patients back to work in a timely manner.

In 2025, I decided to leave employment at AFC, for an opportunity at Beth Israel Lahey Health, in the urgent care department. In this position, I work closely with the primary care department, performing the same type of medical assessments.

My background as a physician associate may not seem lengthy, but I can provide considerable review of cases based on both personal and professional history. In the 3 years I have been a physician associate, I have provided care to more than 15,000 patients. I am consistently one of the top providers at all companies I work at, including patient satisfaction, door to door time, and number of patients I see in a given shift. I put full effort into all that I do and your case will be no exception.
