Board-certified diagnostic radiologist with fellowship training in Emergency and Trauma Radiology at Emory University and extensive expertise in cervical, thoracic, and lumbar spine imaging. Approximately 300,000 imaging examinations interpreted over the course of my career, with a substantial concentration in spine and musculoskeletal MRI.

Experienced in independent imaging review, medical-record analysis, expert consultation, depositions, and trial appearances.
